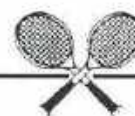
ABOUT THE DIRECTORY

We hope this will promote easier communication between club Executives, Regional Executives and officers and staff of the OTA.

Each member club is included along with details of their current Club Executives and information about the club. The Directory will be updated yearly as both Club and Regional Executives change in the fall and reissued for the start of each summer season. It is also our intention to try to make the Directory more useful every year: let us have your suggestions as you use it.

At our November 1995 Annual General Meeting a comprehensive report was presented outlining the programs and initiatives of the year. The report also commented extensively on your regional executive plans for 1996. For those of you who were not present at the AGM the text of the President's Report is included in this Directory.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT 1995

On behalf of the entire Association executive it is a pleasure to present our annual report to you for 1995. This year was the first we have functioned without the services of a paid administrator. Our program has been undertaken by unpaid volunteers - almost exclusively by your executive committee. That this has not been a more difficult transition is thanks to the willingness of my colleagues on your executive to become much more active in the Association's activities, but it did however result in some delay in getting the this year's programs underway.

I would like to bring to your attention what is happening to the financial resources available to tennis in Ontario because you will be hearing much more about this in the near future and it is important for all of us who are interested in tennis to reflect on what will be needed to meet this challenge. Approximately 1/2 of the discretionary revenue of the OTA is provided by a direct grant from the provincial government. No funds are received from the Federal government and only a small sum comes to Ontario from Tennis Canada. It is very likely that our annual grant will be reduced in next year's provincial budget and perhaps, reduced substantially. At the same time many clubs are under financial stress and can ill afford increases in their OTA membership fees. As your President I sit on the OTA board of directors. This whole issue is under active review by the OTA Board in order to be prepared as much as we can for the anticipated reduction in government funding.

This is one of the main reasons why we in the South West Region decided not to replace our long time administrator who retired last year. Today's reality is that more volunteer participation will be required and we will have to implement our programs more efficiently, if we are to maintain member services without substantial increases in user fees. Happily I am able to report that our first year of operating in this mode suggests that this is not only possible but being more directly involved is also a more satisfying volunteer experience. We can always use more help. Any retiring President or Past President of a community tennis club has experience that would be invaluable on the SWAT executive. If any of you would like to volunteer please contact me or any other member of the executive.

Turning now to the results achieved in 1995 and the programs offered by your association, I wish that it were possible to report an increase in club membership. However despite encouraging beginnings to the summer season, and individual cases of success, it appears that once again, reported overall club membership is lower than in 1994 although I do not yet have final figures from the OTA office. We can report however that the rate of decrease experienced over the past several years appears to be moderating. This is small comfort. There is no secret to building your club's membership. Everyone knows that new members must be recruited and, once recruited *retained*, and this is why the conference portion of today's AGM is focused exclusively on these two issues.

In 1995 we introduced a new program designed to assist clubs in attracting new members called "Give Tennis a Shot!". Much was learned from this first year's operation and it will be offered again in 1996. 8 clubs booked presentations but unfortunately 4 had to be cancelled because of insufficient numbers and only 4 presentations occurred to a total of 130 participants. We will be discussing this program with you in greater detail later this morning.

South West tournament-playing members did not have far to go in 1995. A total of 49 OTA and SWAT sanctioned adult and junior tournaments were held by member clubs. An effort is made to eliminate scheduling conflicts and this was largely successful in avoiding similar tournaments being held on the same dates. Some weaknesses came to light in the Regional Closed Junior Tournament Schedule in 1995 and this will receive our attention next year. So much of what we do is done almost by rote - we do it because it was done last year and we do it the same way it was done last year. Improvements can always be made and we must always be attentive to try to make what we do relevant to our users needs.

In late August a SWAT Roundtable Club Workshop was organized on two subjects - "Dealing With Your Local Municipality" and "Fun Club Tournaments". Invitations were mailed to 175 SWAT member club executives but

nevertheless we were forced to cancel the workshop because of lack of interest. Next year we will try harder to find subjects that you are interested in. Two such events will be scheduled in 1996.

The South West Region hosted the Ontario Cup in June at Rosedale Tennis Club. This is an U14 team event for the 10 regions of the OTA. Each team consists of 4 boys and 4 girls. Seven regions entered teams with the West Central Region besting the West Region in the final. Because some teams come from as far away as Ottawa and the London/Windsor area, we are going to change the competitive format next year in order to ensure that each team competes in at least two matches.

Now I would like to turn to the matter of communications between the membership and the South West Association and the OTA. I do not think there has been a more frustrating subject down through the years and it may very well be that we will never be able to obtain a satisfactory level of interchange. However I believe as never before that the strength of tennis in Ontario is dependant on how effectively the knowledge and resources available are used at the grassroots to enhance and promote the sport. And none of us can do it on our own. The sport of tennis is truly in tune with the times. It can be played not only at all ages but all ages can play together as families. Two tennis outings per week will provide all the exercise you need for good health and on top of these benefits, it is financially accessible. We can therefore justifiably feel good about the time we devote to promoting the game.

Before this year, the Association communicated to primarily one person in each member club, usually the President. Most of the things we do however have a much broader focus involving almost all members of your executive one way or another. Accordingly, despite the expense of doing so, we have decided to try to communicate with every member of your executive and your pro. This effort to tie us together for our mutual benefit was the main reason a Club Directory was published in 1994 and this year, for the first time, the 1995 edition was mailed or delivered to every member of your executive.

We have inaugurated the role of Club Liaison on the SWAT executive this year. One of the most important responsibilities these members of the executive have is this role. A "Club Liaison" has the responsibility of maintaining close contact with a member club for the purpose of exchanging information and answering any questions any member of your club may have concerning OTA or SWAT services. Each of our member clubs has a SWAT executive assigned to them and the name of this person is listed on your page in the Directory.

While these measures have facilitated communications, much more can be done. A major project for next year is the publication of a South West region newsletter. Once again the primary audience is all executives of member clubs for these people are the people who collectively make it happen in our region. Each edition will be mailed to their home address so that we can be sure it arrives at its intended destination in a timely manner throughout the year. More and more people are electronically accessible and our focus on communicating with all your executive will be facilitated by this trend. Within 3 years I predict that we will be collecting and using E-mail addresses for a high percentage of our communications thereby obtaining a quantum leap in timeliness and serious reductions in postage costs.

Another new initiative for 1996 is a semi-annual Club team doubles tournament aimed at adult players who do not normally play competitive tennis. Two weekend tournaments will be held each year - one in March to catch our winter-playing members and one in June for the summer clubs. Attractive prizes will be offered and there will be a parallel social program to encourage participation. These tournaments are being designed to attract teams from at least 80% of our members. You will be hearing more about this early in the new year.

A portion of our annual budget is being set aside for junior player development. No specific program has yet been defined.

In conclusion I would like to pay tribute to the many people who have devoted countless volunteer hours to furthering the sport of tennis in the South West region. Frances Critchley has been active on this Board for 10 years. Next year, while remaining on our Board as Past President, she is going to take a well deserved less active role. John Sorenson from Niagara -on-the-Lake was the club liaison for the Niagara Peninsula and worked hard on keeping the tournament schedule free of conflicts. Angy Bauer joined the SWAT executive during the year and brought many fresh ideas to our discussions as well as serving as the club liaison for Halton. Jill Jones served as our treasurer and undertook the considerable task of putting together and distributing the Directory as well as serving as club liaison for Grimsby and Vineland. Cheryl Sampson is another fixture on the SWAT executive and served as our secretary despite a very busy professional career. Cheryl is also Club Liaison for Hamilton-Wentworth clubs. Scott DeCoste gave unstintingly of his time as Tournament director of the Ontario Cup. Laurie Leek of Rosedale contributed an entire weekend of her personal time to the same event. John Bassett ran the "Give Tennis a Shot" program and was an inspiration to me with his enthusiasm and dedication to the Sport. Patrice Casey donated her time and talent to preparing the "Give Tennis a Shot" press release which garnered more media attention than we have ever had in our region. I also want to thank Pam Olley and Peter Budreo of the OTA for their leadership and support to our endeavours and to all the OTA volunteers and staff and to Sadie Green who was always there to help me over the rough spots.

And finally I want to recognize all of you. I don't think I am wrong in saying that every person in this room either is presently or has served many years on the executive of a community tennis club. On behalf of the sport and your club members, many of whom have no idea of the time you devote, thank you.

HISTORY OF THE O.T.A.

The Ontario Tennis Association was founded at a meeting of tennis enthusiasts in the town of Barrie in 1918, at which certain well known tennis figures, such as Colonel Blackstock, Jack Boys, Garnet Meldrum and Jack Little were present. The following year, the first annual meeting of the O.T.A. was held in Barrie, and Colonel Blackstock was elected the first president. The O.T.A. was incorporated in 1968.

Prior to 1918, the first official Canadian Men's Singles Championships was played on the court of the Toronto Lawn Tennis Club September 2-6, 1890. The winner was an American Mr. E.E. Tanner of Buffalo, New York. The third annual National Championships took place at the T.L.T.C. in 1892, and included a Ladies Singles draw which Miss Osborne won.

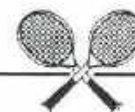

ABOUT THE ONTARIO TENNIS ASSOCIATION PROGRAMS AND SERVICES



The **Ontario Tennis Association (OTA)** was founded in 1918 and, in terms of membership, is the largest provincial association within Tennis Canada which, in turn, is a member of the International Tennis Federation (ITF). It is this linkage from the grassroots to the ITF that ensures tennis is played with a consistent set of rules throughout the world.

The **OTA** exists to encourage broader participation in the sport of tennis in the province of Ontario. We want to ensure proper programs, services and structures are in place to allow all players to reach a level of competence consistent with their personal goals and abilities.

The **OTA** does this through a network of some 229 members including community, private and commercial clubs, municipal parks and recreation departments and resorts. The **OTA** offers a wide variety of programs designed to facilitate the development of players, volunteers, coaches and facilities. We communicate information about tennis in Ontario to the people of this province.

CLUB SERVICES AND RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS

The **OTA** offers many different services to its member clubs. As most of these are not-for-profit community tennis clubs, many of the services are designed to train volunteers to make their jobs easier. These services include:

CLUB INSURANCE

Member clubs are able to secure liability and property insurance coverage through the **OTA**. By pooling the risks and needs of a large number of clubs, the **OTA** is able to secure extremely competitive rates for its member clubs.

COMMUNITY TENNIS SYSTEMS (CTS)

Member clubs have access to an all-inclusive manual and other support materials and equipment that provide a turn-key methodology to increase membership at the club level in both junior and adult categories. Our research indicates that declining membership is the biggest single issue facing our member clubs!

SCHOOLS PROGRAM

The **OTA** Schools Program has been very successful for a decade now. Thousands of young boys and girls have been introduced to tennis because their teachers were a part of an **OTA** delivered Teacher Workshop.

COMPETITION

The **OTA** sanctions over 300 tournaments each year. There is literally something for everyone. Juniors can enjoy events in Under 10, 12, 14, 16 and 18 age categories. Adults have Seniors, Open, A, B and C Class events. All sanctioned events contribute towards provincial rankings. The **OTA** also offers provincial championships in most categories on an annual basis.

COACHING AND INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT

The **OTA** delivers certification clinics as part of a national program to develop properly trained instructors and coaches. Each year, more than 400 people attend these clinics.

COMMUNICATIONS

The OTA is continually communicating information of interest through club mailings to the tennis playing public of Ontario. The Association also produces and distributes **ONTARIO TENNIS (OT)** which is our most important communication vehicle. **OT** is published four times per year and distributed free of charge to member clubs as well as any of their individual members who wish to receive it directly. Inside, you will find information on all aspects of tennis around the province. Of particular interest to many is the Tournament Schedule. It is included with **OT** twice a year.

OTA'S 'WILSON TENNIS FAIR'

This program travels to some 80 clubs each summer offering the members three fun-filled hours of unique tennis programming. Can you serve like Sampras or hit your groundies to the target like Agassi? There are great prizes in it for you if you can! All ages and abilities are welcome at the Fair. Book yours early!

HI TEC PRESIDENTS' DOUBLES CLASSIC

Every year, the OTA offers club executives the opportunity to get away for a weekend of tennis and volunteer education. Participants have the opportunity to learn more about current initiatives in tennis, share ideas with their counterparts from other clubs, receive some recognition for all the hard work they do and enjoy some great tennis. Ask people who have participated and they will tell you this is one weekend you simply **should not miss!**

CLUB MANUAL

This is a complete series of information bulletins intended to guide volunteers in a variety of aspects of club management. Topics relating to Programming, Facilities and Administration are addressed in this comprehensive publication.

Feel free to use us as a resource in ANY tennis-related question your club may have. Many people take advantage of this service. You can too!
